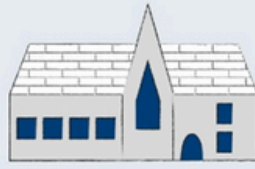
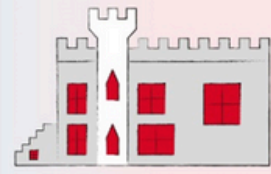

## INTENT STATEMENT

How pupils become linguistics across the Federation...

To meet the National Curriculum objectives, we are using the teaching scheme 'Language Angels'. As a Federation, we aim to ensure we offer a relevant, broad and vibrant foreign languages curriculum that will inspire and excite our pupils with a wide variety of topics and themes.

Our aspiration is for pupils to recall and build on knowledge throughout their primary school language learning journey and be able to use these skills in future education with the intention they become life-long language learners.

Listening, speaking, reading and writing will be taught throughout Key Stage Two, continually building on prior knowledge and key skills, enabling children to progress within each academic year. Grammar will be covered in an age-appropriate way throughout their language learning.

We strive for children to continually broaden their vocabulary and improve accuracy of their pronunciation and intonation. Children will use and apply their learning in a variety of contexts, laying down solid foundations for future language learning and encouraging their love of learning about other languages and cultures, deepening their understanding of the wider world.

Children are encouraged to listen attentively to develop an appreciation for stories, songs and poems and use these to develop practical communication in French by being able to express their thoughts and understand and respond in writing and speech.
